PRAYER AND HUMILITY



Scriptural Reading: Luke 18:9-14

foundation and bond of all virtues. Humility is the bedrock of any strong prayer life. The parable of the Pharisee and the tax collector shows that any prayer offered without humility is an abomination before God. One way we know whether we are humble is the way we conduct ourselves in the presence of God during prayers. We must realize that we are mere creatures in the presence of the creator. We should seek to glorify him and not exalt ourselves when we pray. Our dispositions and gestures in prayer should reflect who God is to us. How we sit, stand, sing and listen to his word should show reverence. During prayers, we should know that we are before God and not man or an equal. If you exalt yourself before him, you will be humbled; but if you humble yourself, he will exalt you (Luke 18:14). We must not wallow in spiritual pride so that our prayers can ascend to heaven.
