PRAYING FOR YOUR ENEMIES



Scriptural Reading: Luke 6:27-28

It is very disturbing to hear Christians pray 'die, die, die by fire' or pray for evil to befall their enemies. This kind of 'evil prayer' upon the enemy can only come from a heart that is carnal and evil. The devil is the evil one and anyone being used by the devil can be redeemed from the devil. This means that an enemy today can be a friend tomorrow. Saul of Tarsus was an enemy of the church but he later became a defender of the church after he was redeemed by Christ. If God had killed him as an enemy, he would not have been used by God.

As believers, we are called to love and pray for our enemies that God may redeem them (Luke 6:27). Those working against you today can work in your favour tomorrow when they are redeemed. Let us resist the temptation to curse and say 'evil prayers' against our enemies. On the cross, Jesus prayed for the forgiveness of his enemies (Luke 23:33). The best way to defeat your enemy permanently is to win him over to your side.

Are you aware that an enemy is destroyed permanently when he becomes a friend?
