Sometimes the difficulties we pass through in life do neither us nor God any good. These painful situations might have been allowed by God with fruitful return in mind. But we, at times, end up wasting those precious opportunities through our response to the situation. Job's friends encouraged him to waste his pain by cursing God at a critical moment in his life but he refused. He understood it clearly that God has purpose for everything in life and waited until God accomplished all he intended to do. At last God was glorified and Job's health and wealth were fully restored.

Pain is painful, so no one enjoys it. But if it is seen in light of God's sovereignty through the eyes of faith, it won't be wasted. Christ's suffering resulted in salvation for us sinners. In the same way, our sufferings, as Christians should produce endurance, character, and hope (Romans 5: 3-5). This can only happen if we unite our pains with that of Christ. It is impossible to do this without faith (Hebrew 11: 6).
