THE GOD WHO ANSWERS BY FIRE

Scriptural Reading: 1kings 18: 16-38



his month is month of prayer. It is a month we need to pray, as we have never done before, to the God who answers by fire. The God of Elijah is our God. He is a prayer answering God. Therefore, pray with expectations. If He answered Elijah, he will surely answer you. Time came in Israel when men lost faith in God. They wandered away through the help of their king Ahab and his wife Jezebel. Jezebel brought the gods of her fathers (Baal and Ashera) into Israel. They led Israel astray until Elijah rose to challenge the idolatrous practice in the land. He declared that it would not rain for three and half years. When he summoned all Israel to the mount of decision, the challenge was that the God who answered by fire would be the God of Israel. Neither Baal nor Ashera could answer their 450 prophets. But the God of heaven answered by fire! This month, the same God will answer you by fire. As you pray, it is rest assured that you will have evidence that God is a prayer answering God.
