CONFESSION OF OUR LIPS

Scriptural Reading: Romans 10: 8-10

It is difficult to see your heart unless you open it. We open it by what we say or do. Some of the words we speak are empty and powerless but others have much power in them. You should be mindful of what you utter with your lips because there is power in word. Jesus commanded the storm through his word and it died down (Mark 4: 39). “You too can use the force of faith, combined with the power of your words to speak to your situation” and it will change.

There is much power in your words, so stop emptying them into nothingness. If the whole world has been created through the word of God, then you too as a child of God can recreate situations through the utterance of your lips. If your word is to be made flesh today, will it save you? “And the word was made flesh and dwelt among us” (John 1:14). Let God's word be in your heart so that it can flow to your lips. Then confess it always.

MEDITATION:

I ask again; if your word is made flesh, will it save you?

STRATEGIC PRAYER POINTS:

1. Pray and cancel all the negative utterances you have made about your life
2. Pray: In the name of Jesus Christ I am blessed with good health; I am blessed with ... Bless yourself and those around you in Jesus name.
3. Ask God to give power to your word for salvation of souls
4. Pray for the Leaders of the Church and of the Catholic Charismatic Renewal of Nigeria,
5. Present your private intentions to God
6. Say your daily prophetic Prayers (Page 6)
7. Pray the act of consecration to the Holy Spirit
