FAITH AND UNDERSTANDING

Scriptural Reading: Heb: 11: 7-11



hen we walk with God, there are many things we may not completely understand. This is not surprising, given that we are mortal and God is eternal; we are physical while God is spiritual. But it is by trusting in His superior knowledge, and following His lead even when we can't fully figure out His purpose that we gradually understand what He is showing us. As someone pointed out, we do not need to know the future; it is enough to know Him who has the future in His hands. In John 6, after many left Jesus, Peter said, "To whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life" (John 6:68). It is not because he understood what Jesus had said, but because his faith told him Jesus would never mislead him. We need to trust God, irrespective of how much we understand.



MEDITATION:

Do I trust God even when I don't understand? Is my faith helping me make sense of what is going on around me?



STRATEGIC PRAYER POINTS

- 1. Ask God to help you to hold on to Him in faith even when you do not fully understand everything.
- Cry out to God: Lord, I trust in You completely in all things. I have confidence in You.
- Say to God: Lord, no matter how dark it is, I want to hold on to You and not let go.
- 4. Ask God to lead you by the path of faith into full understanding.
- 5. Pray for the leaders of the Church for the grace of humility in service.
- 5. Pay now against the spread of corona virus pandemic
- 6. Say the prayers to St. Michael and St. Jude in pages 101 and 103
- 7. Present your private intentions to God
- 8. Say your daily prophetic prayers (page 6).
